Ten Principles for Music Ministry Members— Part 1 of 10 Adapted by Michael Adler

Here is the first of ten principles for Music Ministry Members:

1. You are not singing or playing because you are good.

You have been given this opportunity by God because HE is good. HIS grace has allowed you to represent HIM in spite of your imperfections.

Ephesians 2:4-10 says,

"4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us.

5 Even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by

grace you have been saved), 6 raised us up with Him, and sealed us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. 7 so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; 9 not as a result of works, so that no one may boast. 10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand so that we would walk in them."
