- 4-Who they will take with them

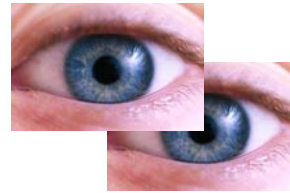
People with *blurred* vision will continue in their frustration because they can't seem to put their lives and their work in any sensible order.
