1. **SIGHT**—God uses visuals to teach important truths (Match these with the Bible stories):

- H. Cross, nails, spear

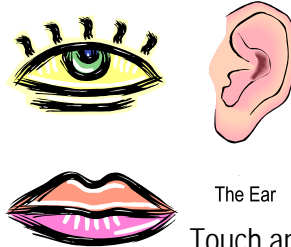

2. **HEARING**—This sense involves any acoustical expression

and many can be used in the worship experience. Music, radio, cassette tapes, CDs, DVDs, TV, surround-sound, movies, movie-clips, dramatic presentations...all use sound for effective impact. Can you hear how thunder...the song of a bird...the wind in a canyon, and the countless other noises of nature all illustrate the importance God places on sound?

3. **TASTE**—Taste is certainly an overlooked sense resource for effective communication in our churches today. Consider Biblical events, such as the manna in the wilderness, the Passover meal,

which used bitter herbs to remind the Israelites of the bitterness of their time in Egypt. The New Testament counterpart, the Lord’s Supper. (Next week-
